- 1. There are a few whistles left over from “Water Watcher Whistles”, (a responsible adult is assigned as the designated ‘life guard’ at home pools and does not drink alcohol during this time period. They must ‘hand off’ to another responsible adult during break periods.) Since the start of home pool season has passed, we may hand out these leftover whistles at local pool stores, such as Leslie Pools, in Valley Stream and Wantagh.**
 - 2. In response to recent terror attacks, we will host a “ ‘Be-Con’Train the Trainor” session this fall, in conjunction with the Nassau Police Department and NYU Winthrop University Hospital. Date to be determined. “Be-Con”is an education seminar for lay people to learn how to treat uncontrollable bleeding wounds. We will also host a Narcan Training session- DTB determined.**

ENPC: September 22-23, 2017**
 - 4. The Nassau County Medical Reserve Core is looking to recruit new members. This is a volunteer core of MD’s, RN’s, DDS, etc. on call for disasters and major events. Members are offered free ACLS recertification. Leaders from this organization will be coming to speak at a future meeting, perhaps October 2017, during Emergency Nurses Week.**
 - 5. Judy Jax, Treasury Report: approximately \$5,500-6,000 in our account with ‘day of’ checks and cash payments from today’s lectures still pending deposit.**
 - 6. Mary Schmidt-Roth, organizer’s debriefing of today’s education day: we are at a “break even” point with our annual education conference regarding conference attendance and costs to our Chapter. Ideas for next year: possibly offer credit card payment or PayPal, although there would be an approximate expense of \$200.00 to set these systems in place. Other ideas would be to expand our advertisement flier distribution next year, invite other area NYSENA Chapters (Suffolk, Bronx/Manhattan) or allow Nursing Students/Fellows a group rate.**
 - 7. The NYSENA pays each Chapter approximately \$5-\$10 per member each year. The total usually is \$300-\$400 per year, which our Chapter usually applies toward our annual Winter Holiday party and some of our annual Education Conference fees.**
 - 8. We are in need of a new restaurant (close to the Nassau/Queens border) for our annual Holiday party. Please send suggestions to Lila, or any of our other elected officers.**
 - 9. Tisha Thompson is President elect for 2018. We will need to vote for a new President elect for 2019 this Fall. All members are being asked to please think of nominees by the October 2017 Chapter meeting.**
